EVENT DETAILS

700m Swim –(minimum age 10 yrs)

Starts at Convent Beach and finishes at Main Beach. **All competitors** must report to clubhouse between 8am and 9:30am on race day for numbering and cap distribution before walking to Convent Beach for race start.

2km Swim –(minimum age 12yrs)

Starts at Main Beach and covers a rectangular course off Main and Convent Beach finishing at Main Beach. **All competitors** must report to clubhouse between 8am and 9:30am on race day for numbering and cap distribution.

Dash for Cash – (Competitors must have completed the 700m or 2km swim to enter)

Swimmers start from a buoy 150m out to sea and race to the finish line on beach.

Late Entries – received on race day from 8 am to 9 am ONLY and will incur a LATE FEE.

- Age as at day of swim.
- All swimmers must be numbered and wear the cap & timing chip issued at registration.
- All timing chips must be handed in after crossing finish line.
- Swimmers doing both 700m & 2km swim use the same timing chip.
- No wetsuits or swim aids allowed.
- Safety craft will be in attendance.
- In the event of surf conditions being too rough the swims may be moved to a safer beach location.
- Prizes awarded to overall male and female placegetters and to the placegetters in each age category (subject to numbers).
- Presentations in clubhouse at 1:30pm.
- Bar and BBQ operating.
- Conditions/details subject to change if deemed necessary by club officials.

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WAIVER, RELEASE & INDEMNIFICATION

In consideration of the acceptance of my entry in "Yamba Ocean Swims"

1. I hereby agree to comply with all of the rules and regulations and event instructions of Yamba Ocean Swims imposed by the Yamba Surf Club and its Officers and organisers.
2. For myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, I hereby waive and release any and all claims I may have against the Yamba Surf Club and the organisers of the swim, their officers, directors, members, volunteers, employees, agents and sponsors or any one or more of them or their executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors or assigns ("the Releasees") including any and all claims for damage, caused by the negligence of any of them arising out of my participating in the event and its related activities, together with any costs including attorneys' fees that may be incurred as a result of any such claim whether valid or not.
3. I hereby indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees and each of them against any such claim that I or my guests or any one or more of my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns may have or assert against any costs including attorneys' fees with respect thereof.
4. I hereby acknowledge that I have the sole responsibility for my personal possessions and effects and any athletic equipment during the swim event and its related activities.
5. I hereby acknowledge that participation in the Yamba Ocean Swims competition carries with it potential hazard. I therefore release the Yamba Surf Club, its Officers and organisers, volunteers, employees and sponsors of any liability resulting from injury or death during the event and its related activities.
6. I hereby attest and verify that I am physically fit and have sufficiently trained for this competition and that my physical condition has been verified by a licensed medical doctor.
7. I hereby consent to receive treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident, and/or illness during the Yamba Ocean Swims.
8. I hereby permit the free use of my name and photo in broadcasts, telecasts and the press as they pertain to the event.
9. I understand that my entry fee is not transferable and in the event that I am unable to compete in the Yamba Ocean Swims a refund will not be issued.

Risk Warning pursuant to Civil Liability Act 2002 (section 5M). Ocean swims are demanding and potentially dangerous events. Risks include drowning, natural obstacles, man-made or controlled obstacles, and marine attack. The Ocean Swim takes place in the open ocean. Swimmers enter at their own risk. You should have a medical check prior to entry, and prepare for the event by training. Water safety craft will patrol the course for the duration of the Ocean Swim. If a swimmer feels unable to proceed further in the swim, the attention of the water safety personnel should be sought. The Ocean Swim organisers cannot guarantee your safety. The Ocean Swim organisers reserve the right to bring to shore by the water patrol any entrants who they deem to be incapable of competing further in the event. While in the competition area - including the beach and water environments - entrants must follow all directions of Lifeguards and Ocean Swim organiser's officials and water safety personnel.
